

Regular Town Board Meeting December 27, 2019

Supervisor Votra opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance at 1 PM.

Code Enforcement Officer Report:

It was discussed that a snowblower to be kept at the Town Hall would be beneficial for keeping the bridge sidewalk cleaned.
